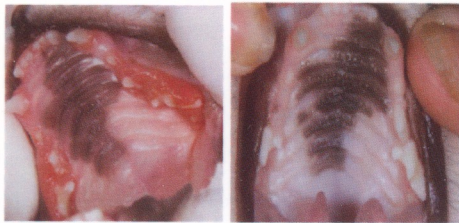

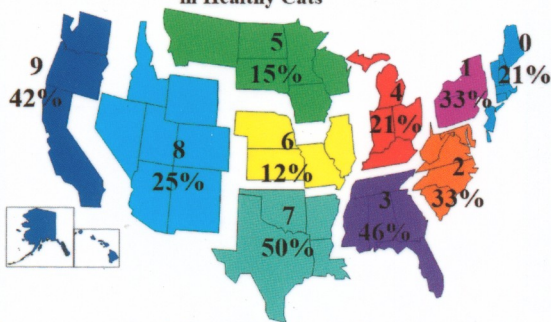


Dermatitis: Skin Papule

Feline *Bartonella* cause inflammatory diseases in any tissue: oral, ocular, respiratory, skin, GI, nervous tissues and major organs.

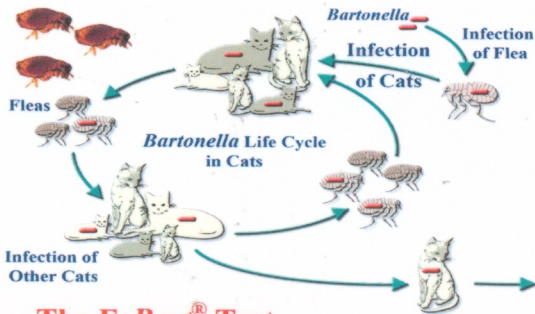
Feline Bartonella Diseases

Zip Code Map and *Bartonella* Prevalence in Healthy Cats



The occurrence of *Bartonella* in healthy cats correlates with the availability of fleas and thus is based on heat and humidity (% infected healthy cats shown by first number of Zip Code in map above). 31% of healthy cats are infected with *Bartonella* in the USA.

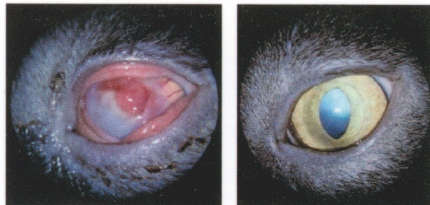
Bartonella Life Cycle- Spread by Fleas
